Room Assignment Policy

Room and roommate preferences may be submitted via the on-line application, however we cannot guarantee preferences.

In order for a request of a specific roommate to be considered, individuals must select each other on their applications. If your preferred roommate has not selected you on their application, the match is not possible. Selected roommates must identify as the same gender as one another in order for the request to be considered.

The Enrichment Studies Unit will make every effort to accommodate requests for specific room types (single or double). In the event that the number of requests for a specific room type exceeds the availability of that room type, the Enrichment Studies Unit will use a lottery to assign rooms of that room type and will place the remaining students in available rooms.

Please note that availability of single or double rooms may be limited. Requests to change roommate and room assignments may be considered until residence placements have been completed for each session (typically one month before each session begins), but are not guaranteed. After placements have been completed room placements are firm and will be released upon arrival to campus. The Enrichment Studies Unit reserves the right to change a room placement at any time.
